

1. Landforms are the natural features found on Earth's surface.
2. Continents and oceans are the two largest types of landforms.
3. Traditionally, there are 7 continents on the earth.
4. Oceans are large areas of salt water between the continents.
5. Oceans cover about 70% of the earth.
6. Mountains have steep sides and high peaks.
7. The low areas between mountains are called valleys.
8. An island is a piece of land that is completely surrounded by water.
9. A peninsula is a piece of land that has water on three sides, but is connected on the fourth to the mainland.
10. Saltwater and freshwater meet and mix in an estuary.
11. Rivers are fed by rainfall or melted snow.
12. A lake is a large body of water surrounded by land.
13. A plain is a large, flat area of land with no mountains or hills.
14. Plateaus are large areas of raised land that are flat on top.
