Vocabulary term	Definition	Visual
Economy	The system by which <u>business owners</u> in a region use <u>productive resources</u> to provide goods and <u>services</u> that satisfy people's <u>wants & needs</u> .	
Traditional Economy	An <u>economic</u> system in which <u>culture</u> determines how <u>products</u> are <u>made</u> , sold, and <u>bought</u> .	
Market Economy	A system that allows <u>business owners</u> to <u>participate</u> in the market w/ little to no <u>government</u> interference.	
Mixed Economy	A system that has features of <u>traditional</u> , <u>command</u> , and <u>market</u> systems.	
Command Economy	A system in which the <u>government</u> decides what <u>goods</u> will be <u>produced</u> , how they will be <u>produced</u> , and how they will be <u>distributed</u> .
